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# The innovation of conductive education

Rainbow Hub promotes independence and achievement for both children and young people, through the philosophy and practice of Conductive Education.

Conductive Education is a holistic educational system using repetitive physical activities incorporating, rhythm, song and phrases to help young people with neurological conditions and brain injury carry out simple movements.

### Conditions include:

- Cerebral palsy
- Hypoxic Ischemic
- Encephalopathy (HIE)
- Williams Syndrome
- Moebius Syndrome
- Downs Syndrome during the early years and acquired brain injury

It can also benefit individuals who do not have a diagnosis and those with global developmental delay, genetic conditions and other physical disabilities.



## More active, independent lives

Conductive Education aims to teach children and young people to develop greater bodily control. CE not only improves motor skills and function, but also looks to build social, emotional and intellectual development as a whole.

## Feel-good fun for everyone

Forget boring appointments. We're all about making learning fun. Conductors and Assistants lead group sessions and will facilitate the children's development of physical and social skills, allowing them more independence. If individual sessions were considered to be of more benefit they may be offered where available.

### Age ranges:

- Parent and child (up to 4)
- Early years (3-5)
- Primary/secondary school (5-10/11-16)
- Young adults (16-25)
