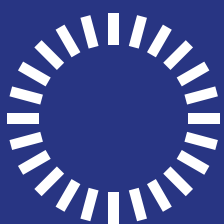

## Raising hopes and dreams

Thanks for choosing to get involved with Rainbow Hub and help children with a range of physical disabilities and neurological conditions to follow their dreams.

We don't receive any government, statutory or public sector funding. Providing our services costs around £592,000 per year, raised purely through the generosity of the local community, businesses, grant funding and Rainbow Hub families.



Funding allows us to enable children to reach the milestones that their families were told may never be possible, helping them to:

- **Improve physical ability and increase independence**
- **Improve social/emotional wellbeing, boost self-confidence and raise aspirations**
- **Improve the welfare of the family unit and their quality of life**

## These are no small victories

Imagine performing the everyday actions most of us take for granted. These are no small victories. These are families rising to the challenges of living with neurological and physical conditions.

Funding will allow us to enable children and young people to reach the milestones that their families were told would not be possible.

### Imagine standing on your own two feet

Jack has cerebral palsy in all four limbs, his family were told he would never be able to sit, crawl, stand, walk or talk.

He has attended Rainbow Hub since the age of two, now ten, Jack can stand, transfer from his chair and say a few words, giving him more independence than ever before.



### Imagine not always coming last

Phoebe is 11 years old, she has a rare genetic condition causing paralysis of the face and is unable to eat so is fed by a tube. She also has curvature of the spine.

At two she began attending Rainbow Hub, only able to sit. The team worked hard to teach her to crawl, stand and walk. She is now able to run and is a strong and independent girl.



### Imagine signing your first word

Abu lives with cystic fibrosis and other complex health needs. When he first attended Rainbow Hub he was unable to walk, talk or even play independently.

The four year old is now able to walk and is learning to sign more and more new words. His family are so proud of all that he has achieved so far.
