## Life Changing Services

Our dedicated team of leading edge specialists offer a holistic approach to health and well-being, with therapies that give disabled children and young people more opportunity to participate and integrate, resulting in a higher level of independence.



### Conductive Education

This holistic educational system uses repetitive physical activities incorporating rhythm, song and phrases, to help young people with neurological conditions and brain injury carry out simple movements.



### Step Safe & Mobility

Our Step Safe and Mobility projects help children achieve their goals in improving balance and co-ordination.



### Physiotherapy

Enabling and empowering an increase in activity, participation and self-management, a dedicated physiotherapist works in partnership with our Conductive Education services to provide a range of therapies.



### Rebound Therapy

Involving the use of a trampoline, we provide fun opportunities for children with physical disabilities

to enjoy the stimulation of movement, therapeutic exercise and recreation.

### Active Movement

Full of soft-padded equipment, our Active Movement Room is a safe, stimulating environment where children can play, move around freely and learn to be independent of their wheelchairs.
